Appeal for Murdered Taxi Drivers Family

The Federation is assisting with an appeal to raise money for the family of Auckland Cooperative Taxi Society Ltd shareholder Hiren Mohini who was brutally murdered early last Sunday morning whilst working.

Hiren Mohini's tragic death means that not only has his pregnant wife, his two young children and his elderly mother lost a loved husband, father and son, they have also lost their family's only income earner and now face a very uncertain financial future.

Hiren's colleagues at Auckland Coop have organized an appeal fund for the family and a trust account has been set up.

The Federation's President Kevin Braid urges all member companies and their operators and drivers to dig deep and contribute to the trust fund; in Kevin's words, "let's show the NZ public that Federation member companies and our people are very generous and caring by strongly supporting the family of the late Hiren Mohini".
